
Throughout this past month, your generous contributions have played a vital role in our efforts to provide love, shelter, and second chances to countless animals in need.

From abuse to happiness







Abandoned Golden retriever dog rescued from Abhishekapakkam, Pondicherry as he was dripping blood from the severe maggot infection he had inside the left ear. Rescued and treated at Bark India, he got healed, sterilised and vaccinated.

After medical care at Bark India rescue centre, he got adopted to the generous family of Ms. R. Reshma, who were the reporters of the dog.

The dog is Bark India's 159th adoption.



A second chance of life

With an eye popped-out, this girl was reported to us from Ariyankuppam, Pondicherry. The eye might have come out due to a severe trauma, a hit, possibly caused by humans.

With unimaginable pain, he got rescued by Bark India rescue team and the affected eye has been surgically removed. She is getting further medical care at Bark India rescue centre.

Relief from mammary tumor growth





She was rescued by Bark India rescue team, when she was reported to us with a burst mammary tumor growth. Being in pain, this girl was desperate at the time of rescue.

After admission, immediate medical care was given and her surgery has been scheduled. The tumor growth was surgically removed after a few days, and she is recovering with post-operation care.

<u>A narrow escape from death</u>

Bathed in blood, this poor dog was reported to us from Anna nagar, Puducherry, and immediately rescued by the rescue team.

A vehicle hit on his face and both the lower and upper jaw got broken with multiple fractures. He underwent an immediate surgery and the mutiple mandibular and maxilliary fractures that caused severe bleeding, were fixed by our veterinary surgeon.

The dog is getting healed as he regained her health back.

118 animals are vaccinated as part of world rabies day
