RESCUE AND TREATMENT -83





In August 2024, Bark India Rescue Centre and Hospital rescued, admitted, and treated 83 animals in critical condition. These animals suffered from a range of life-threatening issues, including wounds,

tumors, and severe maggot infestations.

Every stray in need was given the best care possible within our admitting capacity. Once stabilized, healthy animals were sterilized, vaccinated, and returned to their original locations, ensuring both their well-being and the safety of the community. Those still recovering continue to receive treatment, and we remain dedicated to their full rehabilitation. At Bark India, every life matters, and we strive to provide each animal with a future full of hope and healing.





























As part of World Anti Rabies Day, Bark India Charitable Trust vaccinated 99 dogs in collaboration with local feeders and animal caretakers across different parts of Pondicherry. This initiative, conducted throughout the month, aimed to control the spread of rabies, a deadly disease that affects both animals and humans. By partnering with the local community, Bark India ensured that free vaccinations reached the street dogs, reducing the risk of transmission. This effort not only protects the animals but also contributes to creating a safer environment for humans, promoting a rabies-free society in line with global anti-rabies goals.

Veterinary Surgeries-60



From simple surgeries like hematoma to complex life saving surgeries like amputation, tumor removal etc have been performed at our centre by our veterinary team. 60 animal lives got a second chance of better life through the surgeries.



School Awareness Programme-1





We conducted its monthly school awareness program, reaching hundreds of students with important lessons on animal welfare. The sessions covered essential topics like the dos and don'ts when interacting with stray animals, the importance of adoption, and proper waste management. Students also learned about animal behavior, fostering a deeper understanding of how to care for and coexist with animals.

Through this program, we aim to cultivate compassion, responsibility, and a sense of environmental stewardship among young minds, ensuring a brighter and more humane future.



Vaccinations-116

Throughout the month, our clinic has been providing free Anti-rabies vaccconations to pets and stray dogs apart from the vaccination drive.

Free vaccination for Indie(Mongrel) dogs will be continued for the rest of the year.





This month, a batch of veterinary students from RIVER College, Pondicherry, successfully completed their internship with Bark India. Throughout their time with the organization, the interns gained hands-on experience in animal care, rescue operations, and veterinary treatments. Outpatients-102

Our outpatient service provides the best care for animals- for pets at the minimal cost and for strays, free of cost.

102 animals are treated as outpatients in which all the strays received free medical care, including surgeries.
