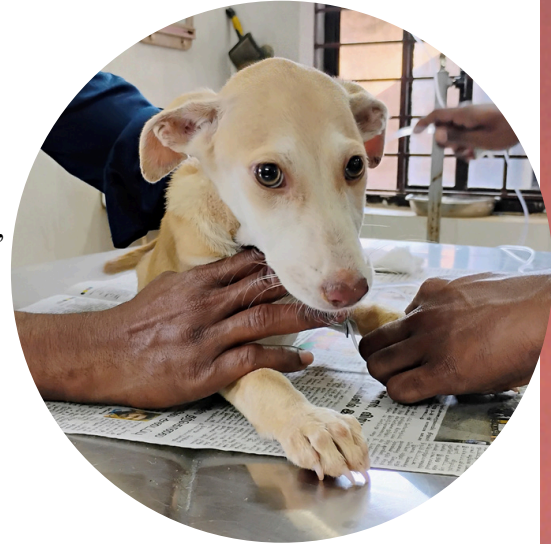

Rescue Operations

Our rescue operations have been the cornerstone of our efforts this year. We have responded to numerous calls from concerned citizens, animal lovers, and caretakers who have reported animals in distress. Our well-trained rescue team has been deployed to various locations, including urban areas, rural communities, and even hazardous environments, to save animals from dire situations. Each rescue operation is carried out with meticulous planning and precision, ensuring the safety of both the animals and our team members.



Admission and Initial Care

Upon rescue, animals are admitted to our hospital and rescue centre, where they undergo a thorough medical examination. Many of these animals arrive in critical condition, suffering from injuries, malnutrition, and various diseases. Our veterinary team provides immediate medical attention, including wound care, surgeries, and emergency treatments. Each animal is given a personalized treatment plan tailored to their specific needs, ensuring they receive the best possible care.

Treatment and Release

Our comprehensive treatment programme includes a range of medical interventions and therapies designed to promote healing and recovery. Animals receive regular check-ups, medications, and follow-up treatments as required. In addition to medical care, we focus on the overall well-being of the animals by providing proper nutrition, comfortable living conditions, and mental stimulation. Sterilization and Vaccination

In the past year, our animal rescue organization has made significant strides in improving the lives of rescued animals through a comprehensive range of veterinary surgeries. We are proud to report that we have successfully performed 843 surgeries, encompassing both routine and complex procedures. Our dedicated veterinary team has consistently demonstrated their commitment to providing the best possible care for animals in need, ensuring that even the most challenging cases receive the attention and treatment they deserve.

A large portion of our surgical efforts focused on spay and neuter procedures of rescued animals. These surgeries are crucial in controlling the population of stray and abandoned animals, preventing overpopulation, and reducing the number of animals in need of rescue and shelter. Our team has tackled numerous cases requiring orthopedic pinning, a procedure essential for repairing fractures and broken bones. These surgeries have allowed many animals to regain mobility and lead pain-free lives.



In some severe cases, amputation has been necessary to save an animal's life or improve its quality of life. Whether due to irreparable injury or severe infection, our team has performed these procedures with the utmost care, ensuring the animals adapt and thrive post-surgery. Tumor removal surgeries have been a critical part of our operations. Detecting and excising tumors has not only extended the lives of many animals but has also significantly improved their overall health and comfort.



Our skilled surgeons have also performed 843 surgeries from complex spinal surgeries, addressing issues that could otherwise lead to paralysis or chronic pain. These intricate procedures have given many animals a second chance at a normal, active life.

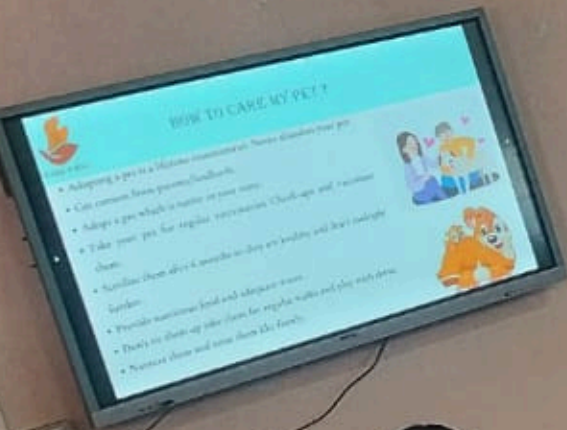

SCHOOL AWARENESS PROGRAMME- 14



In 2019, Bark India launched its School Awareness Educational Program, driven by the urgent need to address the frequent instances of dog bites and related issues that many children in India face.



Recognizing that the well-being of animals and the safety of communities are closely intertwined, Bark India embarked on a mission to educate young minds, believing that focusing on today's children would lay the foundation for a better, more compassionate tomorrow.

The program is strategically conducted in various schools across Pondicherry and nearby regions of Tamil Nadu, targeting school children who are at a crucial stage of learning and development. By engaging with children early on, Bark India aims to instill a deep sense of responsibility, empathy, and awareness towards animals, which they will carry with them into adulthood.

Key Focus Areas of the Programme

The curriculum of the School Awareness Educational Programme is comprehensive, covering a wide range of topics that are crucial for both the well-being of animals and the safety of the community. One of the primary areas of focus is animal welfare, where children are taught the importance of treating animals with kindness and respect. The program emphasizes the need for adoption, encouraging children to understand the benefits of giving a home to stray or abandoned animals rather than purchasing pets.



Another critical aspect of the program is educating children on the dos and don'ts with animals. This includes practical advice on how to approach unfamiliar animals, how to behave around them, and what actions to avoid to prevent provoking an animal. Understanding animal behavior is also a key component, helping children recognize signs of distress, aggression, or fear in animals, which is essential for preventing negative interactions.

Given the high incidence of dog bites among children, the program places significant emphasis on dog bite prevention and rabies prevention. Children are taught how to avoid situations that could lead to bites and are informed about the steps to take if a bite does occur. They also learn about the dangers of rabies, a deadly virus that is prevalent in many parts of India, and the importance of timely vaccination for both animals and humans.

Interactive Learning Approaches

To ensure that the information is not only absorbed but retained, Bark India employs a variety of interactive teaching methods. These include interactive sessions where children can ask questions and engage in discussions, role plays that allow them to act out scenarios involving animals, and PowerPoint presentations that visually reinforce the lessons being taught. Additionally, printed materials are distributed to the students, providing them with resources they can refer to long after the sessions have ended.

Impact and Reach

Since its inception, the program has seen remarkable success. In the past year alone, Bark India has conducted sessions in 14 schools across Pondicherry, reaching over 2,500 children. The impact of these sessions is already being felt, as children are increasingly showing a greater understanding of how to interact with animals safely and compassionately. The knowledge they gain not only helps in preventing immediate dangers such as dog bites but also fosters a generation that values and protects animal life.

Building a Compassionate Future

Bark India's School Awareness Educational Program is more than just an educational initiative; it is a movement towards creating a safer, kinder world for both animals and humans. By educating children today, Bark India is ensuring that the future is one where animals are treated with respect, and communities are better equipped to coexist with the animals around them. Stray Animal Feeding- 350

The onset of the COVID-19 pandemic brought unprecedented challenges worldwide, with one of the most overlooked consequences being the impact on stray animals. As the lockdown restrictions tightened, the streets, usually bustling with human activity, became eerily silent. For stray animals, particularly dogs, this meant the sudden disappearance of their primary food sources—scraps from markets, restaurants, and the kindness of passersby. Recognizing the urgency of the situation, Bark India Charitable Trust initiated a stray dog feeding program in 2019, aiming to provide a lifeline to these vulnerable animals during a time of crisis.



The Birth of the Feeding Program

The program began with a modest yet impactful initiative, feeding around 50-60 stray dogs in the vicinity of Bark India's center. The team, driven by compassion and a deep sense of responsibility, knew that they had to act swiftly to prevent widespread hunger and suffering among the stray population. The pandemic had cut off their access to regular food, and for many, the daily meal provided by Bark India was their only source of sustenance.

As the lockdown extended, so did the reach of the feeding program. What started as a localized effort quickly expanded, with the team feeding more than 550 dogs daily across Pondicherry and the surrounding areas. The scale of the operation grew, driven by the increasing need and the realization that these animals depended entirely on the organization for their survival. The feeding program became a beacon of hope, not only for the strays but also for the community, as it highlighted the importance of compassion and care for all living beings during times of crisis.



Adapting to a Post-Lockdown World



With the eventual easing of lockdown restrictions and the gradual return to normalcy, the program underwent necessary adjustments. The number of dogs being fed daily was reduced to 350, focusing on areas where food availability remained scarce. Despite the reduction, the commitment to the cause remained unwavering. The team continued to venture into industrial zones, harbors, and other locations where strays were still struggling to find food.

This careful selection of feeding sites was based on a thorough assessment of where the need was greatest.

Industrial areas and harbors, often desolate and devoid of human activity, became the primary focus. Here, the strays had few, if any, sources of food, making the daily visits from Bark India's team a crucial lifeline. The dedication to these areas ensured that even in the post-lockdown world, no animal was left to fend for itself.

The Impact Beyond Feeding

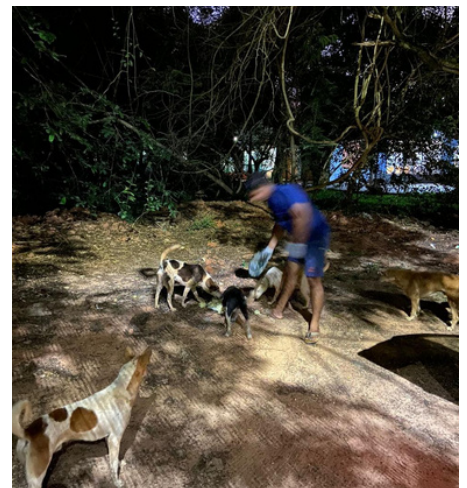

Over time, this trust has made it easier to administer on-spot treatments and conduct rescues, as the dogs have become familiar with the team members. Moreover, the regular feeding has had a positive impact on the behavior of these animals. Dogs that were once wary of humans have become more approachable, leading to a friendlier coexistence between the strays and the local community. This shift in behavior is a testament to the power of consistent care and kindness, which has not only filled their stomachs but also fostered a sense of security and friendship.

The feeding program is a year-round endeavor, carried out without fail regardless of the weather conditions. Whether under the scorching sun or during heavy rains, the team ensures that the 350+ stray animals relying on them are fed every day. This unwavering commitment is a reflection of the organization's dedication to the welfare of stray animals and its belief in the importance of creating a compassionate society.



Through this program, Bark India Charitable Trust has not only provided food to the hungry but has also laid the groundwork for a more humane and animal-friendly community. The trust and friendships formed through this initiative have made it easier to address other aspects of animal welfare, such as medical treatments and rescues, ultimately contributing to the well-being of both the animals and the humans they interact with.

Why Adoption?

Bark India Charitable Trust has always been at the forefront of animal welfare, with its adoption program standing as one of its cornerstone initiatives. Since its inception, the program has been dedicated to finding loving homes for puppies, kittens, handicapped, and abandoned pets, particularly those that have undergone treatment. For these animals, returning to the streets after recovery would often mean facing insurmountable challenges, making adoption their best chance for a happy and healthy life. Through a combination of social media outreach, adoption camps, and lifelong support, Bark India has successfully placed countless animals into their forever homes, while also addressing broader issues within the animal welfare community.

Prioritizing Vulnerable Animals for Adoption

Bark India's adoption program is designed with a focus on the most vulnerable animals—those for whom survival outside of a home environment would be particularly difficult. Puppies and kittens, often too young to fend for themselves, as well as handicapped animals and abandoned pets, are given priority in the adoption process. These animals, having endured hardship or injury, require the stability and care that only a permanent home can provide.

Promoting Indie Dog and Cat Adoption

The decision to prioritize these animals is rooted in the understanding that returning them to the streets could lead to further suffering. Handicapped animals, for example, may struggle with mobility, making it hard for them to find food or escape danger. Similarly, young puppies and kittens are highly susceptible to disease and predation. By focusing on these at-risk groups, Bark India ensures that they are given the best possible chance to thrive in a safe and nurturing environment.



A central goal of Bark India's adoption program is to promote the adoption of indie dogs and cats—native breeds that are often overlooked in favor of more commercially popular breeds. This emphasis on indie animals is not only about providing them with homes but also about challenging the unethical practices of the unlicensed breeding industry.

This industry often treats animals as mere commodities, breeding them for profit and abandoning them when they are no longer profitable. By advocating for the adoption of indie dogs and cats, Bark India seeks to counteract these practices and promote a more humane approach to animal care. Through its adoption program, Bark India encourages the public to see the value in adopting indie animals.



These breeds are often better suited to the local environment, being more resilient and less prone to the health issues that can afflict imported breeds. Moreover, adopting an indie animal is a powerful statement against the exploitation inherent in the breeding industry, helping to reduce demand for bred animals and, in turn, limiting the prevalence of these unethical practices.



Lifelong Support for Adopted Animals

One of the standout features of Bark India's adoption program is the ongoing support provided to adopters. The organization offers free deworming, vaccinations, and sterilization for the lifetime of the adopted animals, ensuring that they receive the necessary medical care at the appropriate times. This commitment to long-term care is crucial in ensuring that the animals remain healthy and well-adjusted in their new homes. The provision of these services also serves as an incentive for adoption, as it alleviates some of the financial burdens that potential adopters might face. By removing these barriers, Bark India makes adoption more accessible to a wider audience, thereby increasing the chances of finding homes for more animals. This comprehensive approach to adoption not only benefits the animals but also strengthens the bond between the adopters and their new pets, leading to more successful and lasting adoptions.

Adoption Camps: Bringing Adoption Opportunities to the Community

In addition to its online efforts, Bark India regularly conducts adoption camps in various locations to promote the adoption of indie dogs and cats. These events provide a platform for the community to meet the animals in need of homes and learn more about the adoption process. By bringing the animals directly to the people, the organization increases the visibility of the adoption program and makes it easier for potential adopters to find their perfect match.



Over the past year, Bark India successfully conducted 4 adoption camps, resulting in 21 animals finding their forever homes. These events have proven to be an effective way to connect with the community and raise awareness about the importance of adoption. The camps also serve as educational opportunities, where attendees can learn about the benefits of adopting indie breeds and the impact of their choices on the broader issue of animal welfare.

Social Media Outreach: Expanding the Reach of the Adoption Program

VETERINARY INTERNSHIP

At Bark India Charitable Trust, we believe in the power of education and hands-on experience to cultivate the next generation of veterinary professionals. Our long-standing collaboration with the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (RIVER) College, Pondicherry, has enabled us to contribute significantly to the practical training of future veterinarians. Each year, RIVER College sends a fresh batch of intern veterinarians to complete part of their internship with us, a partnership that has proven to be mutually beneficial.

At Bark India Charitable Trust, we believe in the power of education and hands-on experience to cultivate the next generation of veterinary professionals. Our long-standing collaboration with the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (RIVER) College, Pondicherry, has enabled us to contribute significantly to the practical training of future veterinarians. Each year, RIVER College sends a fresh batch of intern veterinarians to complete part of their internship with us, a partnership that has proven to be mutually beneficial.

Internship Overview

In the past year, we were privileged to host the entire batch of RIVER College interns. The internship program, spanning 10 days per batch, was meticulously designed to provide these young veterinarians with comprehensive exposure to the field of animal welfare. The interns rotated through various departments, participating in a wide range of activities that go beyond the traditional veterinary practices they encounter in other internship placements such as poultry farms, dairy farms, or general hospitals.

Learning and Exposure

The interns were introduced to the unique challenges and rewards of working in an animal welfare organization. Under the expert guidance of our resident veterinarians, they were actively involved in the treatment and care of rescued animals, including emergency procedures, routine check-ups, and surgeries. The hands-on experience they gained in our surgical unit was particularly valuable, offering them insights into procedures that are not commonly performed in other settings. Additionally, they were educated on the broader aspects of animal welfare, including the legal frameworks governing animal rights and the ethical considerations involved in animal rescue and rehabilitation. These are critical areas of knowledge that are often under-emphasized in more traditional veterinary practices. Our program is designed not just to hone their clinical skills but to instill a deep understanding of the role that veterinarians play in advocating for and protecting the rights of animals.

A Unique Experience

One of the standout features of their internship at Bark India was the exposure to real-world scenarios that they are unlikely to encounter in other settings. For example, the interns were involved in on-spot treatments during our stray dog feeding program, where they had to quickly assess and respond to various medical conditions in an uncontrolled environment. This experience taught them how to adapt to challenging situations and make quick, informed decisions—skills that are essential for any veterinarian but especially for those working in the field of animal welfare.

Another unique aspect of their internship was the opportunity to participate in public awareness campaigns and community outreach programs.

The interns assisted in our school awareness program, where they learned how to effectively communicate the importance of animal welfare to a younger audience. The feedback from the RIVER College interns has been overwhelmingly positive. Many of them expressed that their time at Bark India was an eye-opener, providing them with a new perspective on the veterinary profession. They appreciated the opportunity to apply their academic knowledge in a practical, real-world setting and to witness firsthand the impact that dedicated veterinary care can have on the lives of animals in need.

Several interns noted that the experience broadened their understanding of veterinary medicine, inspiring them to consider careers in animal welfare or to incorporate animal rights advocacy into their future practices. The exposure to a different facet of veterinary work also enhanced their problem-solving abilities, as they learned to navigate the complexities of treating animals with limited resources.

Our collaboration with RIVER College continues to be a cornerstone of our educational outreach efforts. By providing these young veterinarians with a unique and enriching internship experience, we are not only helping to shape the future of veterinary medicine but also promoting a deeper commitment to animal welfare within the profession. We look forward to continuing this partnership and to welcoming future batches of RIVER College interns, who will undoubtedly bring fresh perspectives and enthusiasm to our work.

Vaccination Drive at Pondicherry University

Our first vaccination drive of the year took place within the Pondicherry University campus. This event was a collaborative effort supported by enthusiastic students and dedicated volunteers. During the drive, a total of 50 stray dogs were vaccinated with a combination of the Anti-Rabies Vaccine (ARV) and a multi-antigen vaccine(DHPPIL), which provides protection against several common canine diseases.

The success of this drive was made possible through the kindness and generosity of a donor who sponsored the vaccines. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to everyone involved — the students, volunteers, and our generous donor — for their invaluable contributions in making this drive a reality. Their support ensures that we continue to protect the health of stray animals and, by extension, safeguard the community from zoonotic diseases.



At Bark India, our commitment to the welfare of stray animals extends beyond education and awareness. Every year, we actively engage in providing free on-spot vaccination drives and camps to ensure the health and well-being of stray animals in our community.

In the year 2023-24, we successfully conducted two major vaccination initiatives — one at Pondicherry University and another at our Bark India clinic.

Vaccination Camp at Bark India Clinic

In addition to the drive at Pondicherry University, we organized a comprehensive vaccination camp at the Bark India clinic from September 26 to 30, 2023. This five-day event saw 118 animals, including dogs and cats, benefit from free vaccinations. The camp provided not just vaccination against rabies and other common diseases, but also a general medical check-up and deworming treatments for strays.

The camp aimed to provide a holistic approach to animal welfare, addressing both immediate health concerns and long-term disease prevention. Our team of veterinarians, along with compassionate volunteers, ensured that every animal received the care and attention they deserved.
