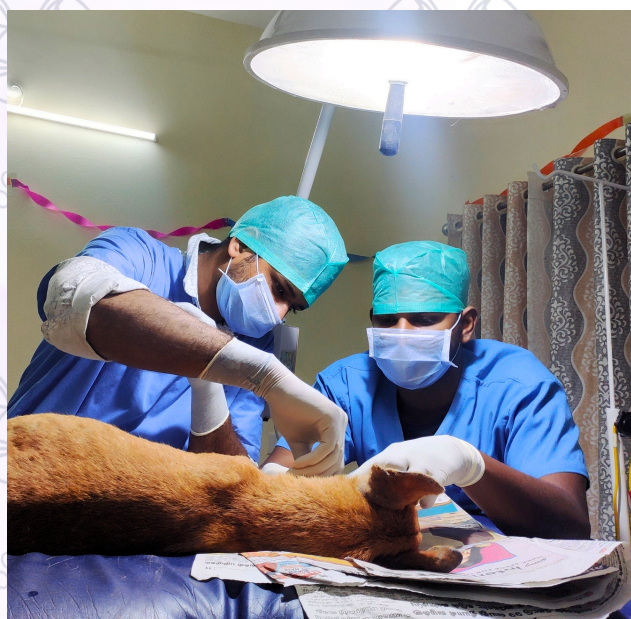


INTRODUCTION

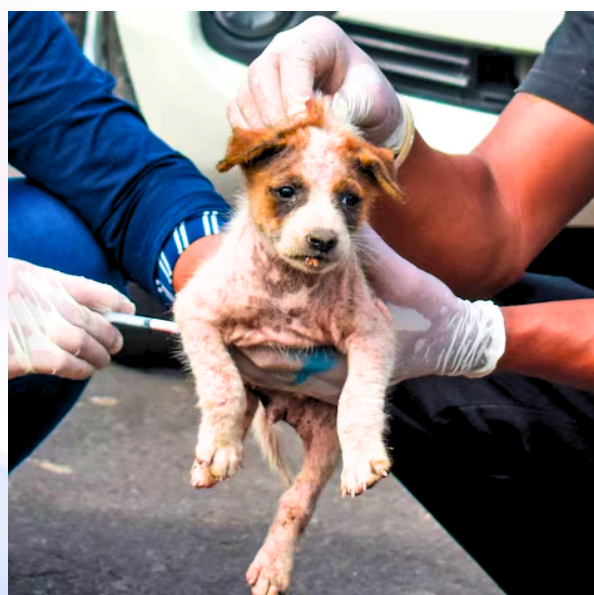
Vision

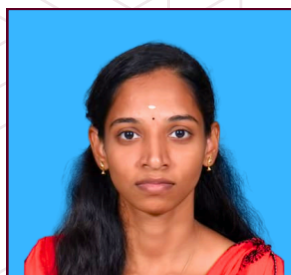

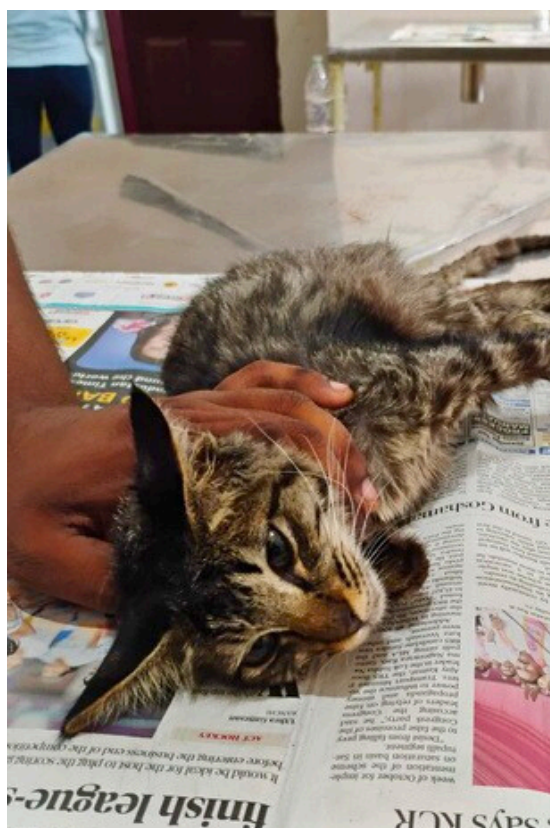

STRAY ANIMALS

RESCUE & TREATMENT





Bark India Charitable Trust remains committed to rescuing, treating, and rehabilitating stray animals in Pondicherry and surrounding areas. This year, our team successfully rescued and provided medical care to [number] sick, injured, and abandoned animals, bringing our total count to over 8,000 rescues since inception. Our rescue service ensures immediate response to accident cases, critical illnesses, maggot wounds, and cruelty- affected animals. Every rescued animal receives veterinary treatment, post- operative care, food and shelter till they recover. Those who recover are either safely released back into their territory or placed for adoption. In addition to individual rescues, we have strengthened our anti-rabies vaccination drives, and awareness campaigns, reducing the spread of diseases and promoting humane animal care. Our mission thrives on the support of donors, volunteers, and the community, helping us create a safer, healthier environment for both animals and people.

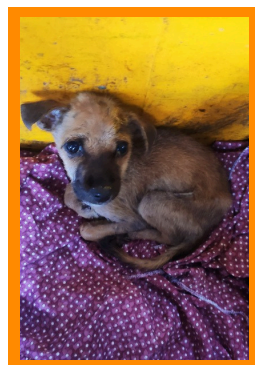
TOTAL NUMBER OF RESCUES IN THE YEAR- 1184





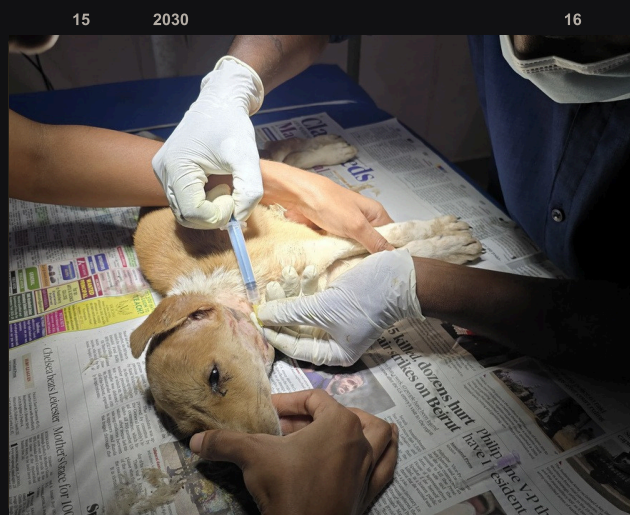
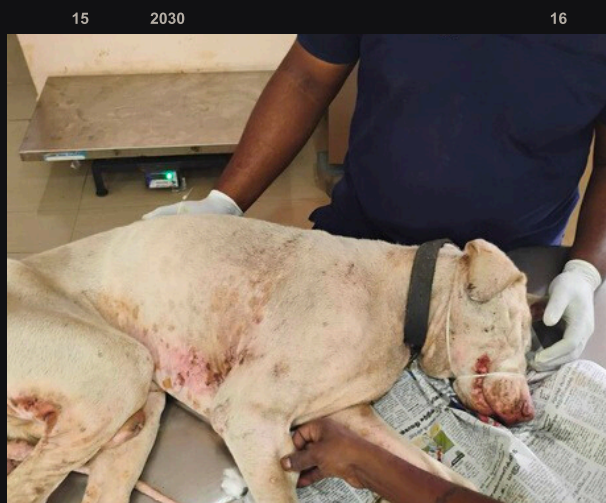
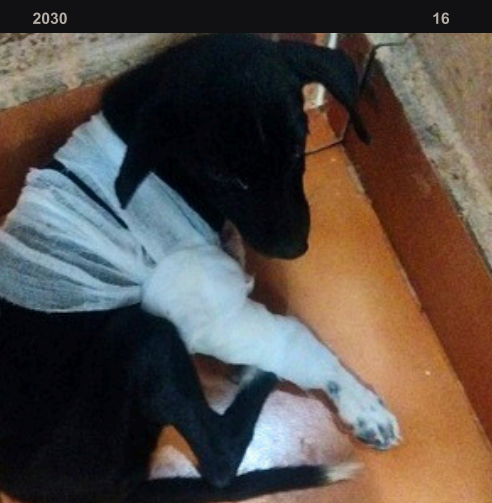
Bark India's Rescue and Treatment Program is the heart of our mission, operating tirelessly every day to save injured, sick, and distressed stray animals. Our extensive process begins with rescue—responding to calls from concerned citizens across Pondicherry and nearby regions. Once rescued, animals receive immediate medical attention, including wound care, disease treatment, and intensive care if necessary.

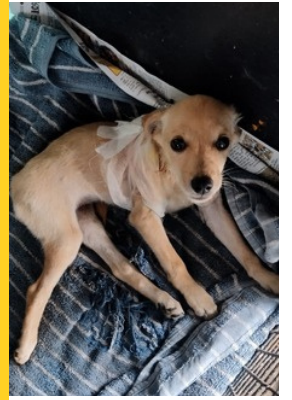
Severely injured or sick animals are admitted to our shelter, where they receive continuous treatment, nourishment, and dedicated care until full recovery. Post-recovery, we ensure their sterilization and complete vaccination before safely releasing them back to their familiar territory in the presence of their informer, custodian, feeder, or local caretaker.



At Bark India, we rescue and treat a wide variety of cases, ranging from maggot-infested wounds, accident injuries, paralysis, and fractures to life-threatening conditions like distemper, parvo, organ failure, tumors, TVT, and other cancers. Many animals suffer from severe infections, malnutrition, and chronic diseases, requiring intensive medical care.

Individual case sheets are maintained for each animal by our doctors. While most of our rescues involve dogs and cats, we also extend our help to injured birds and, occasionally, cows. Each case is treated with dedication and expertise, ensuring the best possible recovery. Regardless of the severity, we strive to provide compassionate care and relief to every suffering animal in need.





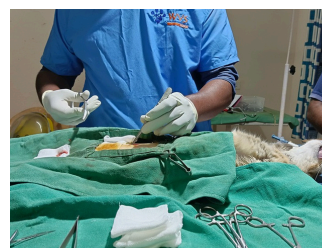
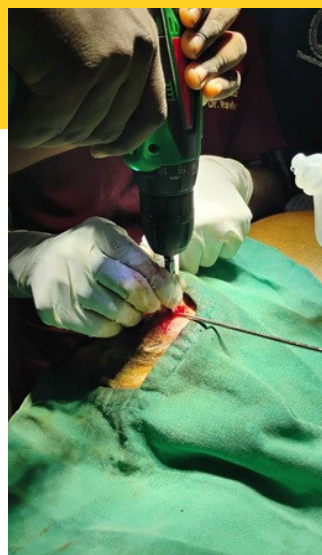


VETERINARY SURGERIES- 821



At Bark India, veterinary surgeries play a vital role in our rescue and treatment efforts, helping animals not only recover from their injuries but also ensuring a better quality of life. Our surgical procedures range from spay and neuter surgeries for rescued animals after their recovery to complex, life-saving surgeries that give them a second chance at life.

We have successfully performed tumor removals, eye surgeries, orthopedic pinning for fractures, spinal fracture surgeries, hematoma treatments, hernia repairs, and other critical procedures. Many animals arrive in distress due to severe infections, road accidents, or debilitating conditions, requiring immediate surgical intervention. Our experienced and skilled veterinary team meticulously handles each case, ensuring that animals receive the best possible care.





Every surgery is conducted with precision and post-operative care, including pain management, wound care, and rehabilitation, to promote full recovery. Sterilization surgeries, such as spay and neuter, also help control the stray animal population and prevent future suffering.



So far, in this year alone, we have successfully performed 821 surgeries, saving countless lives and giving injured and sick animals the opportunity to heal and thrive. Our commitment to high-quality veterinary care continues to make a significant impact on the lives of these voiceless beings.

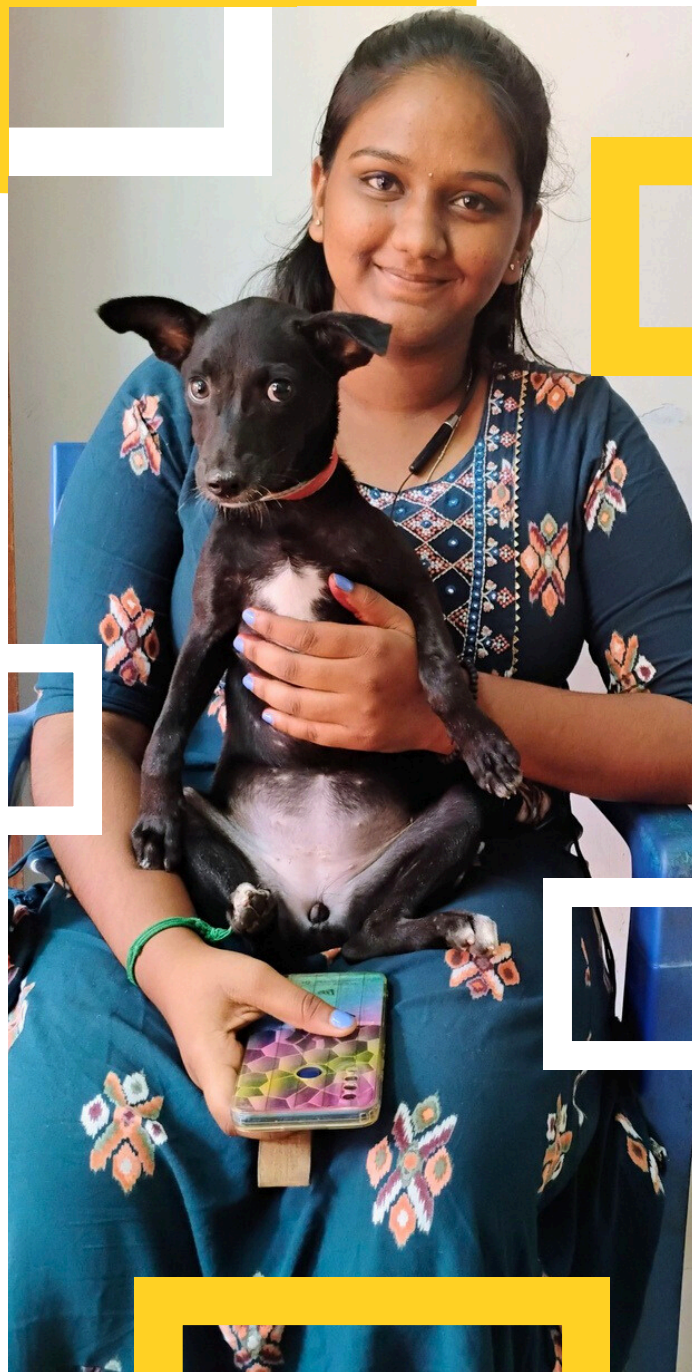

We often conduct adoption camps at different places to reach out to more people with the message of adoption and to promote more adoption.

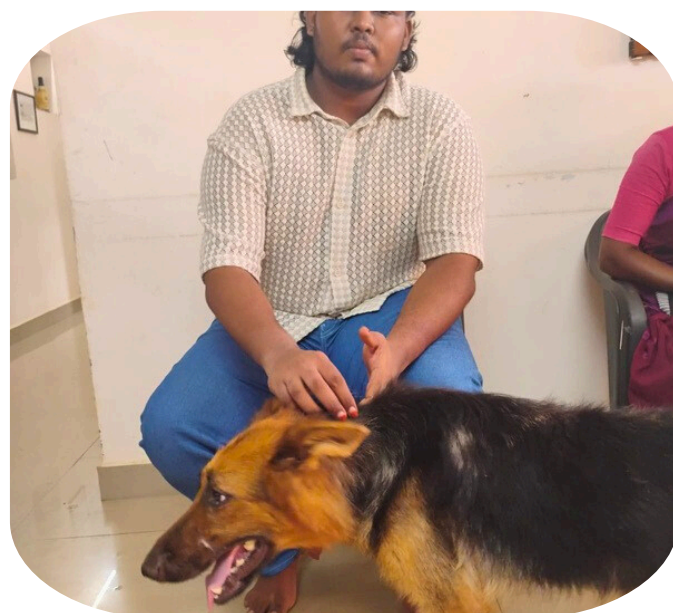
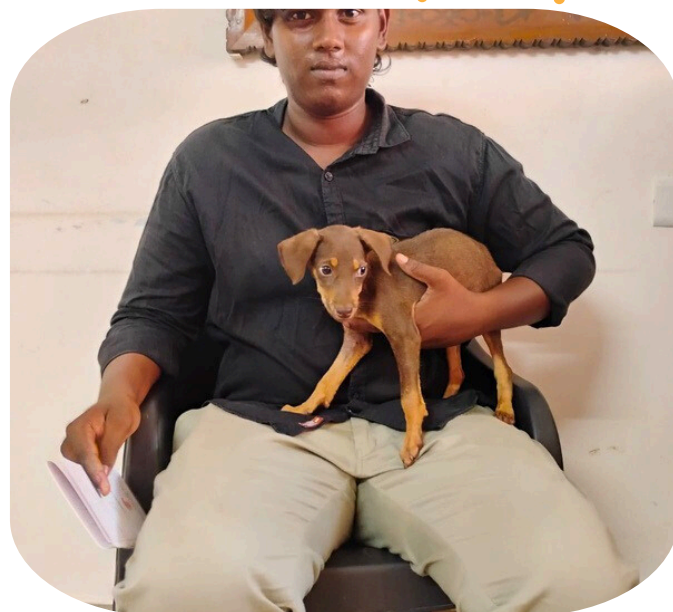

PUPPIES GOT ADOPTED FROM THE ADOPTION CAMP



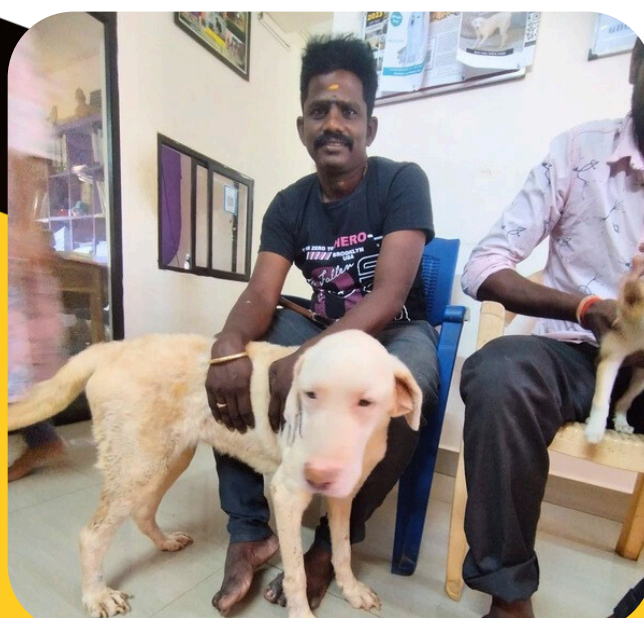
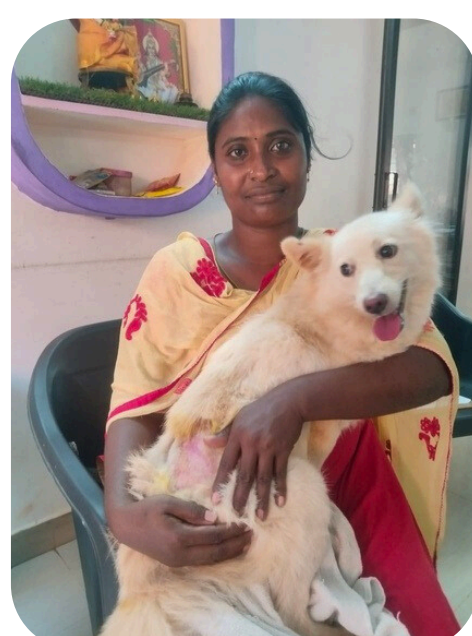

SCHOOL AWARENESS PROGRAMME

STRAY ANIMAL FEEDING



Started in 2020, April, during covid lockdown, Stray Animal Feeding fed 60-70 dogs in our surrounding. Understanding the necessity of food and water during lockdown, the programme expanded to 550 strays in and around Pondicherry, focusing on industrial areas where food availability was scarce.

550 strays were fed for 2 years, and the programme was reduced to 350 animals as the lockdown was over and life became normal.

VACCINATION CAMPS

As part of our project Rabies-free Pondicherry, We have actively been involved in vaccinations. 8 Anti-rabies vaccination camps have been done in the year at different parts of Pondicherry that vaccinated 983 dogs.



Towards a Rabies-Free Pondicherry: 983 Dogs Vaccinated by Bark India

As part of our mission to achieve a Rabies-Free Pondicherry, Bark India has been consistently conducting free Anti-Rabies Vaccination (ARV) drives across the region. Our medical camps have reached various corners of Pondicherry, vaccinating both pet and community dogs to ensure wider protection against this deadly but preventable disease.

Throughout the year, Bark India provided free Anti-Rabies Vaccination for all mongrel (stray) dogs at our clinic. In addition to the on-site services, our dedicated medical team also traveled to multiple locations to carry out door-to-door and street-level vaccination campaigns. From busy urban neighborhoods to quieter village streets, our team made sure that no dog was left unprotected.



FREE ANTI-RABIES VACCINATION CAMP

26-09-2024 TO 01-10-2024

The rabies vaccine is an injection that helps prevent rabies by stimulating the body to produce antibodies against the rabies virus.



A total of 983 dogs benefited from our year-long initiative. This includes stray dogs brought to our clinic by feeders and animal lovers, as well as those vaccinated during our outreach medical camps. By prioritizing free vaccinations for stray and community dogs—often the most vulnerable and overlooked—we are not only protecting animals but also ensuring public safety by reducing the risk of rabies transmission to humans.



We thank our veterinary team, volunteers, community feeders, and supporters who helped us reach this milestone. Rabies is 100% preventable, and with consistent efforts, we can build a safer environment for both humans and animals. Let's continue working together for a healthier, rabies-free Pondicherry.



VETERINARY INTERNSHIP

Veterinary Internships at Bark India: Building a Compassionate Future for Animal Care
Since 2022, Bark India has proudly collaborated with RIVER College, Pondicherry, to host final-year veterinary students for their internship program. In small, focused batches of five, students visit Bark India twice a month, gaining real-world exposure to animal welfare and small animal clinical practice—an experience that stands apart from their regular curriculum.

While traditional veterinary education places emphasis on farm animals, slaughterhouses, and zoo medicine, the internship at Bark India offers students a rare and eye-opening opportunity to work closely with community animals. Here, they learn first-hand about small animal treatments, handling, post-operative care, emergency response, and veterinary surgeries. More importantly, they witness the emotional and ethical side of animal care, which often goes underrepresented in academic settings.



Every batch of students brings fresh energy and leaves with a transformed mindset. Across the board, interns have expressed that their time at Bark India gave them a new perspective—one rooted not just in medicine, but in compassion. They have repeatedly shared that the experience helped them see animals not as mere clinical subjects or resources for human use, but as sentient beings deserving of kindness, dignity, and care.

This shift in perspective is exactly what the veterinary field needs. Compassionate, welfare-oriented veterinarians can make a tremendous difference in how animals are treated and valued in society.



In the last 10 months alone, 72 veterinary students from RIVER College have completed their internship with us. Watching them grow more empathetic and skilled has been incredibly rewarding for our team. Their presence also helps amplify our mission to build a more animal-friendly world, one veterinarian at a time.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to RIVER College for their continued partnership and trust, and we look forward to mentoring many more future vets who choose compassion alongside their profession.



OUTPATIENT SERVICE

Our Outpatient service is committed to provide the best medical care to strays that does not need admission/ those animals who have community care takers to take care of medical care on the spot, and to provide the best care for pet animals and community animals.



Total of 1327 animals (1122 dogs, 173 cats and 32 other animals) are treated as outpatients, in the year.



Our outpatient service is dedicated to stray animals that do not require hospitalization but still need medical attention. These are community dogs and cats that have caregivers or feeders looking after them in their local areas. At Bark India, we provide completely free medical care to such animals, including necessary treatments, wound care, vaccinations, and even minor or major surgeries when needed.

This service ensures timely medical support without removing the animal from its familiar environment. It strengthens community responsibility while ensuring that every stray receives the care it deserves—compassionately, efficiently, and at no cost.
