Rescues - 97

This August, our rescue team rushed to the aid of 95 dogs and 2 cats-victims of accidents, cruel wounds, starvation, and neglect. Each call we received was a cry for help, and each life we touched became a story of courage and resilience.





From broken bones mended with care, to maggot wounds healed with patience, to frightened eyes that slowly learned to trust againevery rescue was a battle against suffering and a victory for compassion.

These 97 souls remind us why we exist: to give the voiceless a chance at life, to turn their pain into hope, and to prove that no struggle is too small when love leads the way.

Surgeries - 87

11 major surgeries gave animals a second chance at life, while 76 Animal Birth Control surgeries helped prevent future suffering and street fights.

🛊 Outpatient Treatments – 114

In August, 114 animals walked through our doors seeking relief from pain. Among them were 89 dogs, 23 cats, and 2 birds—each carrying wounds, infections, or illnesses that needed timely care.

Our outpatient services ranged from first aid for accident victims, to wound dressings, medications for skin infections, and follow-up check-ups for those on the road to recovery.

Vaccinations - 126
